Systems Thinking

Churches like other organizations operate as	<i>Open Systems</i> . The open systems model of
understanding organizations emphasizes the rela	ationship between the external environment and the
organization. In contrast to	_ (which do not interact with their environment), an
open systems view sets the organization in the co	ontext of the environment.

Four Critical Functions when something/someone comes through the system:

1.	Transformation	of inputs of energy and information to produce useful outputs.
2.		with the environment to gain needed inputs and to dispose of outputs.
3.		of system behavior to achieve stable performance; and
4.		to changing conditions.
